Using MiPHY to Make Data-Driven Decisions

This workshop is targeted to school and community agency staff who will be working with the 2007-08 MiPHY data. Participants may attend the morning session or the full-day session. Continental breakfast will be provided. Lunch will be provided to those attending all day.

- Understand the importance of data in making data-driven decisions for school health.
- Learn a process for examining data to make data-driven decisions for school health.

- Review the results of their MiPHY online student surveys.
- Identify areas of strength and need from the MiPHY online student surveys.
- Learn about important considerations for sharing their MiPHY data with school and community stakeholders.
- Learn how to communicate MiPHY Data to stakeholders.

In the afternoon, school or district teams and community teams will:

- Develop an action plan to address one area of need from the MiPHY online student surveys.
- Learn how to bridge data from previous student surveys with the new MiPHY data.
